E. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>

ITEM 2: Public Forum on Coastal Bluffs, Slope Stability, and Maintenance.

Kurth Nelson (Senior Planner) presented an introduction of Coastal Bluff and Local Coastal Program regulations.

Brad Fowler (Director of Public Works/City Engineer Services) presented Education/Past Efforts, and gave a summary on the history of recent bluff failure.

Jason Geldert (Sr. Civil Engineer) gave a presentation on risk reduction measures.

John Tilton (City Architect/Planning Manager) announced that information handouts are available at the Planning and Public Works public counter and would also be available on the City website.

Chairman Denton thanked members of the audience for taking the time to come to the forum.

He also provided the Commission with an update on the survey results of short term vacation rentals in Dana Point that was discussed at the last City Council meeting. Chairman Denton suggested staff consider the safety components for vacation rentals (e.g., noise smoke alarms, and fire extinguishers in every room).

Jennifer Farrell (Deputy City Attorney) noted that the City was reviewing procedures for regulating vacation rentals by other vacation hot spots, e.g. Big Bear, and Mammoth.
