(CEQA). As a result of that review, a Negative Declaration (ND) was issued for the project with the accompanying initial study. The ND was circulated for a twenty day public review period from September 25, 2013 to October 14, 2013. At the end of the comment period, the City received a total of eight (8) written comments.

<u>Recommendation</u>: That the Planning Commission approve the attached draft resolutions recommending City Council approval and adoption of the proposed Negative Declaration and Zone Text Amendment, Specific Plan Amendment, and Local Coastal Program Amendments.

Saima Qureshy (Senior Planner) summarized the staff report, referring to the information contained therein, and gave a PowerPoint presentation.

Chairman Newkirk opened the Public Hearing.

Robin Friend (Dana Point) stated that she is a resident of Monarch Bay Terrace. She indicated that she is a realtor and wondered what other cities were surveyed that had vacation/short term rentals. She also expressed concern about impacts to other residents that live next to or adjacent to short term rentals.

Chairman Newkirk asked Director Luna-Reynosa to comment on the length and depth of what's been looked at, and the provisions there were put in place.

Ursula Luna-Reynosa (Director of Community Development) responded that the City's staff report summarized the history, which addresses a number of public workshops from January 2007 through April 2013 where members of the Planning Commission and City Council surveyed a number of different cities, their ordinances and how they addressed this issue. She spoke about the ordinance adopted in April 2013 by the City Council which outlined the permit regulations. She stated that the issue this evening is allowing this on a Land Use perspective in various zones.

Commissioner O'Connor asked for more specifics about what cities were surveyed.

Christy Teague (Economic Development Manager) responded to Commissioner O'Connor's question; stating that 50 cities were looked at, but initially Newport Beach and Huntington Beach were looked at carefully because of how they have evolved in their implementation.

Commissioner O'Connor stated that it is good that the City can control the short term rentals with a permit. She added that she would be in support.

Robin Friend (Dana Point) inquired if the maximum number of occupants and vehicles allowed will be stated.

Ursula Luna-Reynosa (Director of Community Development) responded yes, it is part of the regulations.

Chairman Newkirk closed the Public Hearing.

Commissioner Denton concurred with Commissioner O'Connor. He stated that the Council has come up with a fair set of rules for short term rentals and allowances for different Homeowners Associations within certain areas of the City. He added that he is in support of the ordinance because it is a step in the right direction.

Commissioner Whittaker stated that she is in support of the ordinance, and it is a positive amendment to the Zoning Code.

Chairman Newkirk stated that the issue has been thoroughly vetted; puts in place methods to monitor and control the use. He stated that he is in support of the zoning ordinance.
