<u>Environmental</u>: Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the project is Categorically Exempt per Section 15301 (Class 1 – Existing Facilities) in that it proposes a nominal increase in square footage to an existing residential dwelling.

Request: Approval of a Coastal Development Permit to allow the addition of 362 square feet to an existing single-family dwelling, on land located within the City's Coastal Overlay District (the California Coastal Zone) and the Appeals Jurisdiction of the California Coastal Commission.

Site Development Permit SDP16-0015 to allow additions to an existing, listed historic resource (a single-family dwelling) located at 33905 El Encanto

Applicant:

33905 El Encanto (APN 682-091-22)

<u>Recommendation:</u> That the Planning Commission adopt the attached resolution approving Site Development Permit SDP16-0015.

<u>Environmental</u>: Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Project is Categorically Exempt per Section 15301 (Class 1 – Existing Facilities) in that it proposes a nominal increase in square footage to an existing residential dwelling and Section 15331 (Class 31 - Historical Resources Restoration/Rehabilitation) in that proposed improvements would not result in a substantial adverse change to the significance of a historical resource.

Request: Approval of a Site Development Permit to allow the addition of 322 square feet to an existing, listed historic resource (a single family dwelling).
