Other amendments are of an administrative or procedural nature and concern themselves with subjects that are not covered by the Code or are reasonably necessary to safeguard life and property within the City of Dana Point. Adoption of these codes as amended will implement the latest codes in the City and complies with current State law; and

#### 2) adopt a Resolution entitled:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DANA POINT, CALIFORNIA, SETTING FORTH FINDINGS WITH RESPECT TO LOCAL CONDITIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF DANA POINT WHICH MAKE CERTAIN MODIFICATIONS AND CHANGES TO THE CALIFORNIA BUILDING CODE, CALIFORNIA RESIDENTIAL CODE, THE CALIFORNIA PLUMBING CODE, THE CALIFORNIA MECHANICAL CODE, THE CALIFORNIA ELECTRICAL CODE, CALIFORNIA GREEN BUILDING STANDARDS CODE AND THE CALIFORNIA FIRE CODE AND FIRE CODE STANDARDS REASONABLY NECESSARY FOR DIFFERENT OCCUPANCIES; and
