RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council (1) ratify the City Manager's action to waive competitive bidding for immediately obtaining construction support services for emergency storm drain facility repairs on a storm drain across Del Obispo Street, herein referred to as "Storm Drain Repairs"; (2) authorize the transfer of funds from the Capital Improvement Program reserve fund to the 2005 Storm Damage Repair Project (CIP#1190) to fund the project; and (3) authorize staff to pay GCI Construction, Incorporated and other necessary contractors, vendors and consultants for completing Storm Drain Repairs upon receipt of actual quantities and costs for the emergency work.
