15. AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROTECTION

Deny the appeal and uphold the Planning Commission's approval of variance V05-08 to allow a new single-family residence to exceed the maximum allowable building height by 5-feet; a coastal development permit CDP05-25 for development in the coastal zone, and a minor site development permit SDP05-65(M) for retaining walls up to 6 feet in height in the residential single family (RSF7) zoning district at 34142 Chula Vista.
