#### **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Wayne Yost (Dana Point) congratulated the City on hosting a great concert this past weekend. He commended staff; and on Saturday Jay Bellamy will be creating a sand sculpture at Baby Beach at 9:00 a.m. through 2:00 p.m. commemorating the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the NASA moon landing.

Ben Valencia (Dana Point) stated that the three astronauts that landed on the moon should be commemorated and worked with Jay Bellamy to develop the sand sculpture idea.

Jay Bellamy (Dana Point) stated that it is an honor to create the sculptures.

C. Borrowe (Dana Point) spoke regarding the recycle center between Ralph's Market and BeyMo on Del Prado and stated that the tractors create a lot of noise.

Bob Oakley (Dana Point / Lantern Bay Villas Association) stated that the recycle center is a nuisance and is attracting homeless people and excess trash.

Parag Gondhalekar (Dana Point) expressed his concern regarding the Gloria Dei columbarium because of his religious beliefs and his concerns for his property value.

Gayle Gomez (Dana Point) stated that she opposes the Gloria Dei columbarium and agrees with the arguments that Parag made.

Deepa Lyengar (Dana Point) stated that she opposes the Gloria Dei columbarium and expressed her concern for a conflict of interest with the staff member involved.

Eva Karndo (Dana Point) stated that she did not receive a notification of the Gloria Dei columbarium hearing and stated that this use should not be a part of the church or near a school.

Lilia Smith (Dana Point) stated that she opposes the Gloria Dei columbarium because of her religious beliefs.

City Manager Mark Denny stated that the project can be denied or brought before the Planning Commission. He added that it may also be appealed by the public to the Planning Commission. He stated that the staff member involved is not a member of the church.

Hoyin Ip (Dana Point) presented a slide and spoke regarding the trash left on the beaches after the 4<sup>th</sup> of July

City Attorney Patrick Munoz reported that a settlement agreement was reached by which the current owner agreed to allow the Receiver to sell the Seaside property. A July 26th Hearing is scheduled with the Judge overseeing the receivership to approve a proposed sale. At the moment, the parties are disputing which of the two potential sales the Court should approve. As part of the settlement, any new buyer will be obligated to complete the renovation work as approved/permitted by the City. Since the permits have already been approved and issued, it is expected that work will commence on the project within a few weeks of any decision by the Judge to approve a sale of the property. In addition, as part of the settlement, any new buyer will be made a defendant in the receivership case in order to allow the court to continue to oversee the renovation work and insure its completed in a timely manner, consistent with the City's approved plans.
