RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council take the following actions:

- 1) Conduct a Public Hearing, declaring the results of the majority protest proceeding; and
- 2) Adopt a Resolution entitled:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DANA POINT TO ESTABLISH THE DANA POINT TOURISM BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (DPTBID) UNDER THE BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT LAW OF 1994 AND CONFIRM THE DPTBID MANAGEMENT DISTRICT PLAN.

Which will result in the formation of the Dana Point Tourism Business Improvement District (DPTBID) and the levy of assessments on lodging businesses.

12. AN APPEAL OF PLANNING COMMISSION APPROVAL FOR COASTAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT CDP16-0014/CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT CUP16-0005 TO CONSTRUCT A NEW 51-ROOM HOTEL AND ASSOCIATED PARKING FACILITIES. THE APPLICANT IS REQUESTING A LOT MERGER, VALET AND TANDEM PARKING, AND MODIFIED PARKING GARAGE RAMPS LOCATED AT 34482 GREEN LANTERN WITHIN THE COASTAL ZONE

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council deny the appeal and uphold the Planning Commission's approval of Coastal Development Permit CDP16-0014/Conditional Use Permit CUP16-0005.

 - A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DANA POINT, CALIFORNIA, SUBMITTING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "2020 TOWN CENTER MEASURE" TO THE VOTERS FOR THE ELECTION CONSOLIDATED WITH THE STATEWIDE AND PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION SCHEDULED TO THE HELD ON MARCH 3, 2020; and
 - b. If the Council takes action to call for an election, consider taking the following actions (all of which are optional, and at the Council's discretion):
 - a. Adopt a motion directing the City Attorney to prepare an impartial analysis
 - b. Adopt a motion calling for the City Council to submit an argument in favor of the 2020 Town Center Measure, and giving related direction to staff regarding how to proceed.
 - c. If the Council takes action to call for an election, adopt a motion by which to transfer \$64,000 from General Fund Operations Contingency Account (99-2999) to the City Clerk Professional Services account (31-2230) for election services.
