SIMILARLY, MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC MAY CHOOSE TO PARTICIPATE ELECTRONICALLY BY LISTENING TO THE MEETING TO WHICH THIS AGENDA APPLIES LIVE ON COX CABLE CHANNEL 855 OR ONLINE ON THE CITY OF DANA POINT YouTube CHANNEL.
