ITEM 6: Art in Public Places - City Website

ARTS AND CULTURE COMMISSIONER REPORTS

Chair Raub: Announced that tonight's meeting will be her last meeting and that her last day as an Arts & Culture Commissioner will be February 11, 2021. It has been a pleasure to serve as Chair this year. Chair Raub has made the decision to move to Delaware.

Commissioner Banks: Was on the same Zoom meeting as Commissioner Schnell during the Cities Art Coordinators meeting and was impressed by all the amazing things other cities are doing.

Commissioner Small: ABSENT

Commissioner Schnell: Maria Elena and Commissioner Schnell had the opportunity to attend a Zoom meeting last week for the Cities Art Coordinators on February 10th and there were 10 cities in attendance. City of Santa Ana is applying for a large grant to do poetry onto the sidewalks. Helping with Artist Safe Places to provide local artists with space to do their art. Also they are beginning their Utility Box Art Program. City of Mission Viejo painted 10' x 10' canopies located outside their library. City of Laguna Beach introduced "Band on the Bus" as well as some temporary art installations around town. They also offered a free, 4-hour marketing workshop for Digital Marketing and E-commerce Fundamentals for Artists with 200 artists signed up for the workshop. City of Irvine Fine Arts Center has been closed but have been providing 360 degree views of their art gallery and making art kits available. City of Buena Park has been working on their Utility Box Art Program and opening up the program to elementary and high school students. City of Laguna Niguel has a new Community Center and anticipating opening in the summer. City of Tustin has a Public Art Committee and they have been working on a mural in a park and a sculpture park.

Vice-Chair Jenkins: For six years the committee has had the Art Walk on Del Prado, however due to the pandemic the dates for this event have been changing, but will likely be sometime in the Fall, however the artists that exhibit in the Art Walk also exhibit in other Southern California areas so trying to find a weekend that doesn't conflict with those other dates will be difficult. Therefore, if the Art Walk doesn't happen in Fall the committee will definitely have it next Spring.
