# Redistricting Process

Step	Description
<b>Two Initial Hearings</b> June 23 & July 20	Held prior to release of draft maps. Educate and solicit input on the communities in the Districts.
Census Data Release August 12, 2021	Census Bureau released official 2020 Census population data.
California Data Release September 20-27, 2021	California Statewide Database released California's official 'prisoner-adjusted' 2020 redistricting data.
Public Hearing #3 Nov. 16	Discuss and revise draft maps and to discuss the election sequence.
February 8	Final draft map posted at least 7 days prior to adoption.
Public Hearing #4 Feb. 15	Discuss and revise draft maps and discuss the election sequence.  Identify recommended final map and introduce an Ordinance to adopt.
March 1	2 <sup>nd</sup> Reading of Ordinance, final adoption date.
April 17, 2022	Legal deadline to adopt map. (Election minus 205)



#### Redistricting Rules and Goals

#### 1. Federal Laws

Equal Population
Federal Voting Rights Act
No Racial Gerrymandering



### 2. California Criteria for Cities (rank ordered)

- 1.Geographically contiguous
- 2.Undivided neighborhoods and "communities of interest"

(Socio-economic geographic areas that should be kept together)

- 3. Easily identifiable boundaries
- 4.Compact

(Do not bypass one group of people to get to a more distant group of people)

#### **Prohibited:**

"Shall not favor or discriminate against a political party."

Minimize voters shifted to different election years


Respect voters' choices / continuity in office
