## **RESOLUTION NO. 22-02-15-02**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DANA POINT, CALIFORNIA ADOPTING DISTRICT MAP AFTER 2020 CENSUS PURSUANT TO ELECTIONS CODE SECTIONS 21607 AND 21607.1

WHEREAS, the City adopted Ordinance 18-03 on May 15, 2018, adopting a bydistrict method of election; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Elections Code sections 21607 and 21607.1, a Statemandated redistricting process, requires the City to hold at least four public hearings, to discuss the results of the census and its potential impact on the City's district voting map.; and

WHEREAS, Public Hearings were held June 23, 2021, July 20, 2021, November 16, 2021, and February 15, 2022 where public comment and draft maps were solicited; and

**WHEREAS**, Elections Code section 21621 allows a city to adopt district boundaries by resolution decision to elect its council using district-based elections.

WHEREAS, The City Council finds and determines the District Map attached as Exhibit A meets the requirements of the Elections Code and such other requirements imposed by law.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the City Council of the City of Dana Point does hereby Resolve as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The District Map attached as Exhibit A shall be adopted until the next decennial census in 2030.
