Please see the correction to Action Document A – Proposed Utility Undergrounding Assessment District Policy/Guidelines:

Utility Undergrounding – A Step by Step Guide, Page 2, "Option One – Fast Track", Step One:

The last sentence currently reads:

Property owners are required to put down a \$10,000 deposit to cover Consultant costs.

Option One - Fast Track

1. The process is initiated by an interested property owner, who acts as a liaison between the City, utility companies, and neighbors. The property owners who support undergrounding submit a letter to the City's Public Works Department expressing their interest in forming an Underground Utility Assessment District. The letter should include a description of the proposed boundaries of the area to be undergrounded. Property owners are required to put down a \$10,000 deposit to cover Consultant costs.

Will be replaced with in the final version, if approved by Council:

Property owners are required to put a deposit down for the cost of the consultant. Those costs are not known until a project has been identified.
