ITEM 4: A request for Historical Resource Application (HRA09-0002) for the property located at 26805 Calle Real and presentation of the plaque to the property owner.

Applicant/

<u>Property Owner:</u> Chris Carter and Janet Petterson <u>Location:</u> 26805 Calle Real (APN 123-244-31)

<u>Request:</u> To designate a single-family residence located at 26805 Calle Real as a historic structure, and place the residence on the Dana Point Historic Resource Register.

<u>Environmental</u>: This project is categorically exempt (Class 31 - Section 15331 – Historical Resource Restoration/Rehabilitation) from the provisions of the

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California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) because it consists of preservation of an existing historical single-family residence.

<u>Recommendation</u>: That the Planning Commission adopt a Resolution designating the single-family residence located at 26805 Calle Real as a locally significant historical structure and present the bronze plaque to the property owner.

Evan Langan (Associate Planner) reviewed the staff report.

Chairwoman Fitzgerald opened the Public Hearing.

Chris Carter (Property Owner – Capistrano Beach) spoke about the property's aesthetics and reviewed his family's history with the home for thirty-nine years.

Barbara Johannes (Vice Chair of Historical Society – Dana Point) stated that she was pleased to introduce the home on the Historic Resource Register and gave some background on the residence. She distributed invites to attend the Historical Society's Home Tour and Hawaiian luau at Doheny State Beach on September 27, 2009.

Chairwoman Fitzgerald closed the Public Hearing.

Commissioner Denton stated that he is in support of the designation because of its richness of life and architecture.

Vice Chairman Conway stated that he is in support of the designation and would plan to attend the Home Tour and Luau event.

Commissioner O'Connor stated that is it always nice to preserve historic homes and she supported the designation.

Chairwoman Fitzgerald spoke in support of the designation.
