Jennifer Farrell (Assistant City Attorney) gave an update on the City's pending litigation against illegal medical marijuana dispensaries. The recent appeals filed by the dispensaries were denied by the Courts, and so they have petitioned to the Supreme Court.

John Tilton (City Architect/Planning Manager) announced that the City Council held their 2nd reading of Coastal Commission modifications to the Dana Point Harbor Land Use Plan document. He added that the Implementation Plan is going through review to ensure that the added policies are compatible.
