<u>Request:</u> Approval of Antenna Use Permit AUP10-0001 to allow the addition of seven, new cellular antenna facilities within an existing cupola atop the roof of the Marriott Laguna Cliffs Hotel.

F. STAFF REPORTS

John Tilton (City Architect/Planning Manager) briefed the commission on forthcoming projects including new hotels, cellular antennae installations, church expansion and others.

He reported that while some Town Center (condominium) projects are presently on hold, owing to the tenuous state of the housing economy, he added that at least one property owner has expressed interest in creating a mixed use office/retail at the street level.

In response to Commissioner Claus, Mr. Tilton elaborated the Coastal Commissions' difference of opinion regarding the Headlands access.

G. COMMISSIONER COMMENTS

Commissioner Newkirk stated the whale (nicknamed "Lily") observed in the Dana Point Harbor brought a lot of attention and news coverage, and he thought the community's efforts to get involved was a great learning experience on how fragile things can be.

Commissioner Claus also stated that it was nice to see the publicity, but sad there was not a happier ending to the story. She gave kudos to all the members of the community involved in the valiant rescue effort, while giving tribute to Lily.
