## RE-APPROPRIATION OF CITIZENS OPTION FOR PUBLIC SAFETY (COPS) PROGRAM FUNDS FROM FY 2009/2010 – (AB 1913)

Any action or proceeding to attack, review, set aside, or void any decision of the Dana Point City Council is controlled by Section 2.50.010 and Section 2.50.020 of the Dana Point Municipal Code. In any such action or proceeding seeking judicial review which attacks or seeks to set aside, or void any decision of the Dana Point City Council shall be limited to those issues raised at the hearing as provided in Chapter 2.50 of the Dana Point Municipal Code.
