13. MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT AND PROPERTY EXCHANGE WITH THE COUNTY OF ORANGE FOR MAINTENANCE OF THE NORTH STRAND BEACH ACCESS STAIRS AND ASSOCIATED FACILITIES

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council 1) approve a Maintenance Agreement with the County of Orange for maintenance of the North Strand Beach Access Stairs; 2) authorize the City Manager to execute the Maintenance Agreement and approve any minor administrative modifications; 3) approve the Quitclaim Deed and Grant Deed for two parcels in the Headlands Strand Vista Park area to clarify property ownership, and authorize the City engineer to execute the documents; and 4) authorize the City Engineer to accept and sign various grant deeds and easements to clarify property ownership in the Headlands Strand Vista Park area at the Headlands.

The changes and modifications to the 2010 Editions of the California Building, Residential, Plumbing, Mechanical, Electrical, Green Building Standards and Fire Codes are reasonably necessary due to local conditions in Dana Point. Other amendments are of an administrative or procedural nature and concern themselves with subjects that are not covered by the Code or are reasonably necessary to safeguard life and property within the City of Dana Point. Adoption of these codes as amended will implement the latest codes in the City and complies with current State law; and

(2) adopt a Resolution entitled:
